The following outline details the landscape maintenance provided by our service teams this week, ensuring we meet the specific needs of the community and address any weather-related delays.

### LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE

## Turf Grass Mowing and Ponds

Completed all mowing and weed eating on both campuses this week Mowing will continue daily on both properties (LBTS & River Club) Mowing and weed eating will continue weekly in Compass Point

### Ornamental Detailing

Trimmed the shrubs throughout the Litchfield community and detailed around the Beach Club House.

### Fertilization, Weed Control & Pest Control Services

Weeds were sprayed throughout the entire property in LBTS, River Club and at the Beach Club House.

## Irrigation Inspections & Maintenance

The system will be routinely inspected for operational efficiency and condition. Visual inspection will include the controller and electronic components, spray and rotor heads, and shrub risers.

Repairs for malfunctioning, broken or worn-out components (heads, line breaks, controllers and electronics, pumps, etc.) will be done after client approval.

### Cozy Autumn Veggie Soup

# *Ingredients* (4–6 bowls)

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- 2 carrots and 2 celery stalks, diced
- 2 cups cubed butternut squash or sweet potato
- 4 cups low-sodium vegetable broth
- 1 cup baby kale or spinach, chopped

Salt and pepper, to taste

Lemon wedge and parsley

#### **Directions**

Warm olive oil in a pot. Sauté onion, carrots, and celery for 5 minutes.

Stir in the squash, then add vegetable broth. Simmer for 15 minutes until tender.

Add greens and cook 2 minutes. Season with salt and pepper, squeeze lemon, and garnish with parsley. For a creamy texture, blend half the soup and return it to the pot.

Warm soup hydrates and comforts. You can blend it smooth or keep it chunky depending on chewing comfort.
