Dear Litchfield-By-The-Sea Owners,

Important information regarding the LBTS Flower Beds

We have been working with our Landscape Maintenance Partner to identify ongoing issues with our entry flower beds. You may have noticed that the flowers in some of the Oceanside beds and River Club beds are struggling. After an analysis involving soil testing, we have identified the problem and found a solution. Below are the details:

The flower beds at LBTS and River Club are currently experiencing several underlying issues, including alkaline soil, excessive calcium/carbonates, nutrient lock-up, low potassium, low organic matter, and sodium toxicity. While the technical details can get complicated, the takeaway is that these conditions are preventing the beds from performing the way they should.

We have consulted a soil specialist who is an expert in this area. Based on his recommendations, our immediate course of action is to deadhead the existing flowers and apply a heavy application of Milorganite. He advised against making any major soil amendments at this time. He recommended making more aggressive corrections closer to the spring/summer flower installation.

Therefore, about a month before the spring/summer flower installation, our vendor will perform a full renovation of the beds. This includes leveling the beds, bringing in a high-quality soil blend with a heavy compost component, and incorporating granular sulfur to help correct the pH levels. At that time, we will also apply soil fungicide to help prevent fungal issues once the new flowers are installed.

Additionally, the River Club flower beds have consistently had issues with deer feeding on newly installed plants. To address this issue, we will spray the newly installed flowers with a product called Bobbex. This is pet-friendly and works by emitting a scent that deer find unpleasant, helping keep them away from the flower beds.

We appreciate your understanding and patience as we take the steps necessary to ensure healthy, colorful, and long-lasting flower beds within LBTS.
