Administration News & Updates:

Dear Litchfield-By-The-Sea Owners,

We have some exciting Security Enhancements occurring within LBTS, and I'd like to share a few of those with you.

South Gate Entrance – The renovation of the South Gate guardhouse is nearly complete. Once the final access control and IT equipment are installed, the gate will be fully operational and staffed daily from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Beginning in early February 2026, the following changes will take effect:

- Commercial Traffic: All commercial vehicles must enter the Oceanside Campus through this gate. This will help to improve the main gate entry experience for owners and their guests.
- Enhanced Service: Staffing will be provided during peak hours to manage traffic flow, assist service providers with access, and enhance community security.

2nd Patrol Officer/Vehicle – Starting this weekend, we are doubling our nightly security presence to enhance patrol coverage and reduce security response times.

- Dual Patrols: Two roving patrol officers will be on duty every night.
- Dedicated Zones: One officer will be assigned to the Riverside campus and the other to the Oceanside Campus.
- Nightly Schedule: The 2nd patrol officer, assigned to the Riverside Campus, will operate from 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

River Club Gate Attendant – As part of the 2026 budget, the Board has approved staffing for the River Club main gate from 8:00 AM to 12:00 AM (midnight) daily. To support this change, we are implementing the following enhancements:

- New Smart Call System: We are installing a high-tech call system to manage vehicles arriving overnight without credentials. When gatehouse staff is not present, this system allows guests to communicate directly with Security for authorized access.
- Rapid Response: The new Riverside roving patrol officer will be available to respond immediately to any overnight access issues at the River Club main gate.
- Next Steps: We will provide River Club owners with detailed instructions once the new call system is fully operational. Stay Tuned...

Maintenance News & Project Updates

Each day, your LBTS Management Team coordinates and performs many small & large repairs across both campuses. However, when larger projects may impact owners/guests, we will provide details regarding those projects so you can plan accordingly. - Signage work is ongoing throughout the community. This includes installing new signs at the Oceanside Main Gate and South Gate. These signs will direct owners into the right lane for 'Owner Only' access. All other vehicles will be directed to the left lanes for guest and/or vendor access.
- New Tennis court windscreens have been installed.
- Two new light poles have been installed at the South Gate.
- Enhanced landscaping has been installed around the newly renovated South Gate.
- New security cameras are scheduled to be installed at the South Gate.

River Club

- We are continually working on signage throughout the property.
- The guard house on site has been inspected, and new equipment is ordered to accommodate the change in staffing.

Landscaping News and Updates

The following landscape maintenance update is provided by our Landscape Maintenance Partner, United Land Services, to ensure we meet the needs of the community and address any issues caused by weather, pests/bugs, accidents, etc.

LBTS Common Area Landscape Maintenance

- Turf Grass Mowing and Ponds
 - Completed all mowing and weed eating on both campuses this week.
 - Mowing will continue daily on both properties (LBTS & River Club)
 - Mowing and weed eating will continue weekly.
 - Concrete curbing has been edged throughout the community.
- Ornamental Detailing
 - Trimmed the shrubs throughout LBTS
 - Detailing around Beach Club
 - Removal of vines and volunteer weeds will continue as needed
 - Pine straw has been installed in the beds where needed. Pampas and muhly grasses have been trimmed throughout the community.
- Irrigation Inspections & Maintenance
 - Weeds were sprayed throughout the entire LBTS property
 - Weeds were sprayed throughout the entire River Club property
 - All weeds were sprayed around the beach club
